#### Attendance Letters

If your child is absent for a <u>full day</u> or <u>partial day</u>, it is important to let the school know why your child was not at school. A written note to the school explaining your child's absence or contacting the school personally to provide an explanation is a legal requirement. We thank the many parents/caregivers who always promptly explain such absences.

In an attempt to reduce the number of unexplained absences, our school has started to send home a letter asking you to explain any full or partial absence days that your child has. If you receive one of these letters we ask that you please explain your child's absence and return the note to your child's teacher as soon as possible.

Your cooperation to explain your child's absences is very much needed and appreciated.

At the moment we have a number of applications for students who are 'out of area'. These will only be accepted if there are vacancies after local enrolments.

- · Proof of students residential address
- Birth certificate or identity documents
- Immunisation history statement
- Copies of any family law or other relevant court orders (if applicable)

Please be aware without these documents we will be unable to accept your enrolment.
