Starting Kindergarten in 2016

If you have a pre-school child turning 5 years old on or before 31st July 2016, they are eligible to enrol in Kindergarten for 2016.

If you haven't already done so, please collect an enrolment form from the office and return it to school ASAP.

If you are aware of neighbours or friends with eligible children, please advise them to come and introduce themselves and ask for an enrolment form and information about the school.

Parents approaching students or other parents in the school grounds or school building

It is Blairmount Public Schools policy that parents do not approach students or other parents in our school grounds or buildings to address disputes or grievances. If you have a concern regarding a student or parent please direct this concern through an appointment with the classroom teacher, The Deputy Principal Melissa Clarke or the Principal Greg Turnbull. Parents are not to interfere with school proceedings or the good order of the school in any way.

Principals have the authority to take out an enclosed lands act order against any person who places the health or safety of our students, staff or other parents at risk. I seek your cooperation and support in this matter.

Students walking to school safely

Over the last few weeks a number of concerned community members have contacted the school with concerns about our students safety while walking to school. The staff at Blairmount will be doing a safety talk with the students about how to walk or ride to school safely. We ask all parents to also do the same at home. The safety of our children and families at Blairmount is paramount and we appreciate your support with this matter.

Attendance

It is of utmost importance that children come to school everyday and arrive before the 9am bell, ready to commence their day of learning. Lateness is extremely disruptive to the late child and all children in the class as vital instructions and learning may need repeating. We are asking all students and parents to support us in this area. If your child is away or late for any reason a note outlining the reason must be provided to the school.
