We are starting to finalise our numbers for our Kindergarten enrolments for 2017. It is important that parents intending to enrol their child in 2017 complete the necessary paperwork so all appropriate communication regarding support or transition programs can occur prior to enrolment. Early notification of enrolments also assists the school in planning staffing and resource needs. Children born between 1st August 2011 and 31st July 2012 are eligible to enrol. Please bring with you - child's birth certificate for proof of age, passports and visas for families born overseas and proof of residence (current council rate notice or lease agreement and 2 (two) utility bills e.g. gas or electricity account, plus mobile or landline telephone account). You will also need to bring your child's up to date immunisation certificate.

The Big Day In










Show Week




On Channel 7


Student Feedback
