
All students were outstanding and showed great sportsmanship on the day.






Writing in K/1R

Over the last few weeks, staff at Blairmount have been working hard to get our very own sensory room open, we have officially called it 'The Rainbow Room'.


Sensory rooms are very beneficial for students in regulating their behaviour and emotions.


